Free Youth Summer Programs at Minneapolis Parks

Join Registration fees have been eliminated for all youth programs, activities and sports leagues based at Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board (MPRB) parks, recreation centers and facilities within census-designated "areas of concentrated poverty." This new policy applies to any Minneapolis resident 17 and under signing up for any activity at one of 17 MRPB sites within a designated area. Browse the parks and programs.
